Now when I worked as a cocktail waitress, I did have a terrific boss so I never walked out on him. The money was good, my boss was great, and I stayed there until I moved out of the state.

The point to this story is that I was not happy, not even as a waitress. I just stayed with that job because of the great tips (nothing beats a 20 dollar tip when you're used to working in restaurants where the customers left quarters) and the boss terrific. But the work was very degrading.

At that time in my life I felt empty and useless, but worse, I felt as if I was failing my children.

And to me that's the worst feeling in the world. When I worked at the tobacco company I worked 12 hour shifts, and the drive was an hour away. It hurt to live day after day working, going home, showering, getting some sleep, getting up, eating a sandwich, hugging the children and running out the door to get back to work on time, while my mother raised (she was my babysitter at the time) my children almost 24/7.

I wanted nothing more than to be able to raise my children myself, but I KNEW I had to pay those bills as well.

If you're a single parent you probably know exactly how I was feeling. It's a painful experience to be able to witness 3 of your children's first steps, then coming home one day with the first words greeting you being "Dar took his first steps today!!"

Dar Dar is my son, and to this day it still hurts because I missed something special in his life because I was not there. The memory of his first steps is something I will never have now, and that's very painful.

That was also the day I literally said "F*** it, I'm tired of this". Excuse my terms of expression, but I decided THEN to do something about it, and I made up my mind that I was going to find a way to do both. I was determined to pay the bills and still be there for my children, and that was the exact attitude I took.

The problem is, well, I didn't have any support. None of my family members said "Maria, you can do it, go ahead and try". They said instead "Maria you have to take care of those children, how are you going to pay the bills?"

Yes they had a point, BUT why couldn't they have said "I'll support you in any way I can to help you get where you feel you need to be". Instead they showed me that IF I was going to get to where I wanted in life, then I was going to have to do it alone.

I quit the tobacco factory job (I was making \$22 an hour at the time and they thought I was crazy) and found a job driving senior citizens and special children to school, centers, and social functions.

That job paid \$150 a week, and was salary based, BUT I had a job where my boss was caring (thank you Linda), and the hours were such that I could spend most days doing my morning run (took about 1 to 2 hours) then doing my evening run. So it was more like a part time job for me.

Although the money wasn't the best, I now had more time with my children and also more time to focus on my career for a change. It was time for me to make myself money instead of helping make someone else rich.

But once more I struggled, because I didn't know which way to go. I didn't exactly know what I wanted to do, and I sure didn't know a single thing about anything online. But a computer was all I had to use to make a living from home because I sure couldn't afford start-up fees for all the other home based businesses I'd have liked to have tried (as I said I also had no support from family either...they thought I'd flipped my rocker).

These days you can find hosting very cheap. I've seen plans for less than \$6.95/month that offer the world, promise 99% uptime, and a full-featured control panel. Sounds good doesn't it? But, believe it or not, this just isn't enough to take me away from my Host4Profit account.

Let me explain...

Choosing a good web hosting company is a very important decision and should be based on more than just who gives the most stuff.
